

Pre-Wedding Checklist

Congratulations and best wishes! You're getting married, and you have a lot of decisions to make. Use this Pre-Wedding checklist before coming to the Clerk & Comptroller's office for your Marriage License.

Requirements

To get a marriage license, you must:

- Be unmarried; and
- Be at least 18 years old. (For applicants under 18, contact us to learn about additional requirements.)

When and Where You Can Use Your Marriage License

Your marriage license:

- May be used anywhere in the State of Florida.
- Must be used within 60 days.
- Must be returned within 10 days.
- Is valid to be used based on your residency:

If neither of you are a FL Resident: VALID SAME DAY

If one or both of you are FL Residents:

VALID AFTER 3RD DAY

(Providing a Premarital Counseling Course completion certificate allows FL Residents to marry the same day.)

	Government-issued, photo ID (Driver's License, Passport, Military ID, State-issued ID card)
	Date of Birth.
	Social Security Number (No card needed, just know the number.)
	Cash, credit card, check, or money order to pay the license fee of \$86.00
	Premarital Counseling Certificate of Completion (For FL Residents only, Optional)
	Exact date your previous marriage ended
	(Either by death, annulment, or divorce – No copies needed, just know the date.)

	Apply for your Marriage License online at www.SarasotaClerk.com .
	Read the Family Law Handbook online, before you arrive.
	Take a Premarital Counseling Course to pay a reduced license fee. (For FL Residents only, Optional)
	Consider getting married at the courthouse for only \$30.00.
